

BON BON/EBA Regolith - Landforms

REGOLITH TYPES

Transported regolith

Includes alluvium, colluvium, eolian, glacial, lacustrine, and marine deposits.

- Aluvial (A)** - Deposited by rivers and streams.
- Colluvial (C)** - Deposited by mass wasting.
- Eolian (E)** - Deposited by wind.
- Glacial (G)** - Deposited by glaciers.
- Lacustrine (L)** - Deposited in lakes.
- Marine (M)** - Deposited in the sea.

Residual regolith

Includes regolith formed in situ from the weathering of primary rocks.

- Basaltic (B)** - Derived from basaltic rocks.
- Dioritic (D)** - Derived from dioritic rocks.
- Gabbroic (G)** - Derived from gabbroic rocks.
- Granitic (GR)** - Derived from granitic rocks.
- Quartzitic (Q)** - Derived from quartzitic rocks.
- Schistose (S)** - Derived from schistose rocks.
- Siltstone (SI)** - Derived from siltstone.
- Sandstone (SD)** - Derived from sandstone.
- Schistose (SH)** - Derived from schistose rocks.
- Siltstone (SH)** - Derived from siltstone.
